Also ensuring these courses fulfill the electives required for the AAS.
2. Take MTH 263, PHY 201, PHY 202, CHM 111, and CAD 201 to fulfill MATH 211, PHYS 111N, PHYS 112N, CHEM 121N/122N, and CET 120 requirements for BSET in CET.
3. This course can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the category of Human Behavior. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
