This form is for active duty military members and their spouse/dependents, veterans, and spouse/ dependents using Chapter 33 and 35 benefits who may not qualify as being domiciled in Virginia for the purposes of in-state tuition. While this exception may result in a student being eligible for educational benefits reserved for those domiciled in Virginia, it is not a determination of domicile status. **COMPLETE A, THEN CHOOSE ONE CATEGORY (B, C, D, or E)**

B. SPOUSE/DEPENDENTS (Code of Virginia §23.1-505):

Spouse/Dependents of active duty military personnel (or activated/mobilized reservists or guard members) shall be considered domiciled in Virginia and afforded in-state tuition privileges if the military sponsor is one of the following:

- a. Assigned to a permanent duty station or workplace in Virginia, or a contiguous state or the District of Columbia, and resides in Virginia;
- b. Assigned unaccompanied orders and immediately prior to receiving such orders was assigned to a permanent duty station or workplace in Virginia, or a contiguous state or the District of Columbia, and resided in Virginia
- c. Assigned unaccompanied orders with Virginia listed as the designated place to which to move.

The qualifying conditions must be in place at the time of acceptance to the college for dependents currently residing in Virginia or by the final add/drop date for dependents of service members newly transferred to Virginia. Please note in-state tuition is based on continuous enrollment. Once enrollment is broken (excluding Summer semesters), tuition rate will return to the out-of-state rate.

Note: If a military sponsor does not live in Virginia, under federal guidelines, Spouse/Dependents of active duty military personnel (or activated/mobilized reservists or guard members) shall be afforded in-state tuition privileges if the military sponsor is assigned to a permanent duty station or workplace in Virginia and resides in another state.

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C. ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY: In-state tuition good for 3 semesters/one year. Student responsibility to renew.

(Code of Virginia § 23.1-505) Active duty military personnel (or activated/mobilized reservists or guard members) who either reside or are stationed in Virginia shall pay no more than the in-state tuition rate. Active duty member must provide the following:

Current Military Orders (to include activated or temporarily mobilized guard or reservist members).

D. VETERANS OF MILITARY: In-state tuition good for 3 semesters/one year. Student responsibility to renew.

(Code of Virginia § 23.1-505): Veterans discharged or released from military service under conditions other than dishonorable who reside in Virginia shall pay no more than the in-state tuition rate. Student/Veteran must provide the following documents:

DD Form 214 (Member Copy #4), PHS form 1867, or NOAA Form 56-16

Proof of Living in Virginia (examples: utility bill, lease, deed, settlement statement, letter from landlord showing current Virginia Address, housing agreement from military housing office).

E. SPOUSE/DEPENDENT USING EDUCATION BENEFITS: In-state tuition in effect while using benefit.

Students who live in Virginia (regardless of their formal state of residence), who are enrolled at Tidewater Community College and use education benefits under Chapter 33 or 35 of Title 38, United States Code.

Student must provide the following documents:

Proof of using Chapter 33 or Chapter 35 each term

Proof of student's current Virginia residence (ex: utility bill, lease, housing agreement)

F. STUDENT CERTIFICATION:
