The committee discussed the possibility of a future Specialization for Teacher Licensure and recommended that the revision for Social Sciences be approved as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

V. Action/Information Items

a. Health Professions Discussion on NAS 2 Prerequisite to BIO 141/142

Ellyn Hodgis and Stacey Deputy presented the committee with statistics regarding the pass/fail rate of students who complete the NAS 2 requisite before they complete BIO 141. Due to the additional time it causes Health Professions students to complete NAS 2 (in order to enter their respective program) the faculty has recommended removing the NAS 2 prerequisite and fund special tutoring sessions with the money that would be used to hire adjunct faculty to teach a NAS 2 course. The committee advised the faculty presenting return to a later meeting with a Faculty Requisite Request and a proper vote recorded from all BIO faculty for consideration.

A request will be made at the January 2019 meeting for a committee member to sit on the General Education Committee as a voting member as well as remain on the Curriculum Committee as a voting member. This will allow the newly appointed members to record a vote.
